If you are in the assist mode (the menu is still visible), press the Esc key as many times as necessary to switch to the dot prompt mode.

Using the Dot prompt mode

It used a runtime interpreter architecture, which allowed the user to execute commands by typing them in a command line 'dot prompt.' Similarly, program scripts (text files with PRG extensions) ran in the interpreter (with the DO command). dBase programs were easy to write and test; a business person with no programming experience could develop applications.

Clipper is an xBase compiler that implements a variant of the xBase computer programming language. It is used to create or extend software programs that originally operated primarily under MS-DOS. Although it is a powerful general-purpose programming language, it was primarily used to create database/business programs.
